Dear Parent

There has recently been some confusion in the Academy with regard to our uniform expectations in terms of trousers. I would like to confirm to parents that our uniform remains unchanged specifically with students wearing grey trousers/grey school skirt.

Because of the confusion, we will allow students who have bought black trousers to wear them for the rest of the academic year. Parents should be clear though, from **1st September** students should be wearing grey school style trousers (not tight fitting/leggings), or for girls a knee length, **grey** school skirt.

For the remainder of this term, please note that although we will allow black trousers for those who already have them, black jeans, leggings etc are not allowed. Our Academy and our students are regularly commended for our smart appearance and we would like to keep it this way. I would appreciate your support with this.

Ormiston Uniform

A number of parents have contacted me regarding requirements for purchasing a new Ormiston uniform.

There will be **no change** to our existing uniform until **September 2018** and this is likely to only be a slight change to our logo. Therefore as of September 2018 we will phase in the new uniform; meaning when it naturally arises for parents to buy new items they will be the new logo.

To be clear, we do not expect any parents to purchase any new uniform if existing uniform is fit for purpose.
