### I agree that I will:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ always keep my passwords a secret.</li> <li>➤ only visit sites which are appropriate to my work at the time.</li> <li>➤ work in collaboration only with individuals or groups agreed by my teacher or other responsible adult.</li> <li>➤ tell a responsible adult straight away if anything makes me feel scared or uncomfortable online.</li> <li>➤ make sure all messages I send are respectful.</li> <li>➤ inform a responsible adult if I get a nasty message or get sent anything that makes me feel uncomfortable.</li> <li>➤ do not reply to or forward any nasty messages or anything which makes me feel uncomfortable.</li> <li>➤ never meet an online friend without taking a responsible adult that I know with me.</li> <li>➤ do not give my mobile phone number to anyone who I don't know or have not met.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ only email people I know or those approved by a responsible adult.</li> <li>➤ only use e-mail systems which has been provided by the Academy.</li> <li>➤ only connect to the agreed Academy wireless broadband while in the Academy.</li> <li>➤ talk to a responsible adult before joining chat rooms or networking sites.</li> <li>➤ I will inform a responsible adult if I come across anything in chat rooms or networking sites that makes me feel uncomfortable.</li> <li>➤ always keep my personal details private. (My name, family information, journey to the Academy, my pets and hobbies are all examples of personal details)</li> <li>➤ always check with a responsible adult and my parent / carers before I upload photographs of myself.</li> <li>➤ not use any unauthorised hardware or software that is not provided by the Academy ICT Support Team.</li> </ul>
